California COVID-19 Factoids

- California Cases – Increasing Significantly

222,917

Positive Cases

+6,367 New Cases

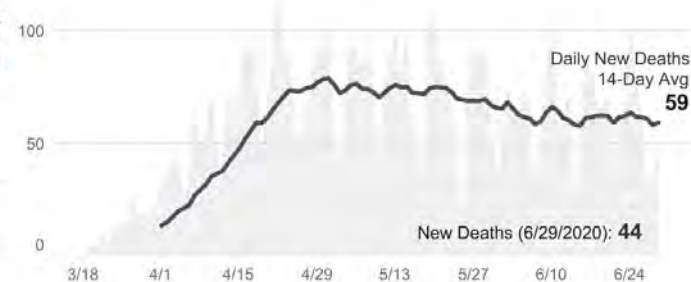
+2.9% Increase

5,980

Total Deaths

+44 New Deaths

+0.7% Increase

California COVID-19 Factoids

- 5,898 (6/30) new positives
- Testing: Over 105k Yesterday, 87k Today
- Positivity Rate - 6% Over 14 Day Period
 - 14 Days Ago - it was 4.6%
 - 7-Day Positivity Rate: 6.4%
- Hospitalizations - 5,196 - 51% Increase
 - From 2 weeks ago (Capacity = 7%)
- ICUs - 47% Increase from 2 Weeks Ago
 - 1,617 Currently in Use = 15% of all ICUs



California COVID-19 Factoids

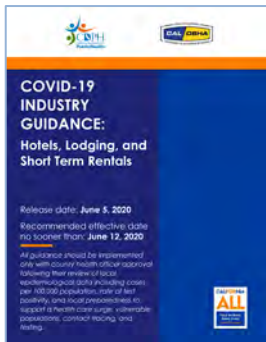
- Preliminary June 2020 Occupancy Data
 - Running Four Weeks – May v. June
 - Anaheim - 28.0% / 36.1%
 - Los Angeles - 37.5% / 42.3%
 - San Diego - 36.8% / 43.2%
 - San Francisco - 26.2% / 32.3%





Re-Opening Status

- Hotels are Open 6/12-19
 - 54 of 58 Counties
 - No Bay Area Counties
 - Marin County:
 - **Rescinded Opening**
 - **No New Timeframe**





Re-Opening Status

- Governor is Cautiously Optimistic
- Enforcement Increasing*****
 - LA County Asking for Hotel Plans
- Industry “Dimmer Switches”
 - Dine-In Restaurants in 19 Counties
 - Beach Closures / Family Gatherings
 - Amusements
 - Disney Voluntary Pull-Back

 - Restaurants
 - Wineries & Tasting Rooms
 - Movie theaters
 - Family Entertainment Centers
 - Zoos and Museums
 - Card Rooms

- Signage/Protocols
 - Reception/Front Desk Sets the Tone
 - Engage Guests on Safety/Cleanliness
 - Set Expectations!!!
 - Laundry in Hallways
 - Allow for Frequent Pick-Up

- Risk Assessment
- Guest Services
- Employees
- Food Service & COVID-19
- Employee Training Materials & Signage
- Exposure Incident Report



REQUIRE

Re-Opening: Employee Training

- Simple Yet *Very* Important
- Two Methods:
 - CDC Materials
 - Presentation (English/Spanish)
 - Group/Video Conferencing
- OPTIONAL:
 - Cleaning + Disinfecting Facilities

Re-Opening: Employer Resources

- **Model Supervisor Talking Points**
Be proactive to address concerns and questions that may arise.
- **Employee Temperature Testing**
The Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) allows it.
In California, a notice is required pursuant to the California Consumer Privacy Act.
- **What Employees Should Know**
Encourages employees to gather information from only credible and reliable sources.





Employee Considerations

- Self-Symptom Checks
 - By a Specific Time Prior to Shift
 - Consistent Application
 - Litigation Risk
 - Wage + Hour Issues
 - Compensating Employees



Employee COVID-19 Positive Considerations

- If an Employee Tests Positive
 - Shut Down Not Required
 - Restaurants/Manufacturing
 - 6-15 Rule:
 - Physically Distance – Six Feet
 - Exposure for 15 Minutes
 - Notify Those Affected
 - Clean + Disinfect Areas
 - Do Not Disclose Employee Name



Meetings Considerations

- Currently On-Hold
 - State/Governor's Office is Engaged
 - Timing!
 - Protocols
- San Mateo County - Groups Allowed - 50/Less
 - Lots of Certainty



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
